- **Award Acceptance Deadline:** Selected mathematicians must confirm their acceptance of the award by April 20, 2025. Grants not accepted by this date will revert to IMSA and be redirected toward other activities aligned with IMSA's mission.
- **No Application Process:** Please note, these grants are awarded exclusively by the IMSA academic committee based on scholarly merit and achievement; applications or nominations from the public are not accepted.
